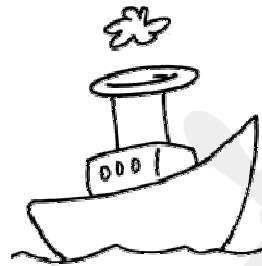

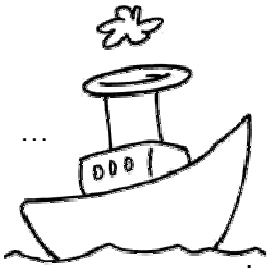

March 21, 2005

Meeting was held on March 21, 2005 at the Tallahassee Ale House and was called to order at 6:10 PM by President Bridget. Agatha gave the invocation and led the pledge to the flag. There were 12 Pilots present with 2 guests.

Treasurer's report was given by Treasurer Charlotte and approved as submitted. She reported that there was still some outstanding pecan money and that she would not be at the next meeting.

Cathy Yoshikawa gave an updated report on Project Lifesaver. She was most impressed with the 3-day training program conducted on March 16<sup>th</sup> through March 18<sup>th</sup> and reported that the project was well received. ## Recipe of the Month

### Chicken Casserole

from Pam Manley  
serves 6

4	each	chicken breast
32	ounces	chicken broth
6	ounces	herb stuffing mix
1	can	cream of celery soup
1	can	cream of chicken soup

Boil or roast breasts until done. Allow to cool for several minutes.

De-bone the chicken by tearing or cutting off from the bone. Set aside.

In a large mixing bowl, combine the cream of celery, cream of chicken. Slowly add the chicken broth, stirring to combine.

In a 9 x 13 casserole dish, make a layer of dressing followed by a layer of chicken then a layer of soup mixture. Continue until dish is full, ending with dressing on top.

Bake for 20 minutes at 350 or until bubbly.
