## minutes – June 4-amended

The meeting was called to order at 6:15 pm by Bea Mizell, President-Elect.

**Minutes:** No corrections were noted, and minutes were accepted (published in Deck Chatter and emailed out ahead of time for review). A motion to accept the minutes was made by Lucretia and seconded by Linda Summerlin. Motion to accept the minutes carried.

**Treasurer's Report:** No report presented.

**President Elect's Report:** Bea said at the June 18<sup>th</sup> meeting we would begin collecting "Pennies for Pilots" again. The money collected will be used to buy a brick at the Heritage House.

### **Committee Reports**

**Club Operations:** Bea reported that Secret Pals would be revealed at the June 18<sup>th</sup> meeting. Please bring a \$5.00 gift and a card for your Pal. This meeting will also be the Strategic Planning meeting (Division Meeting) and will be casual. Lucretia will arrange for the dinner.

**Fundraising:** Carol is grateful for the pecans sold at District Convention (\$266). Linda S will call the Greek Orthodox Church to see if they are interested in buying our pecans at \$5/bag. Karol will provide the list of how much is owed by Pilots, for pecans, at the next meeting.

### **Projects/Youth**

**Projects:** Bea, Bridget, Linda S, Lucretia, Dora, Karol, Pam, Annarene and Claire attended Kids Fest and distributed all our helmets (approximately 380). Claire has tried to get more helmets from the Epilepsy Foundation but was told there weren't anymore. She contacted the Department of Health and asked when we should be receiving the 75 helmets that were not in our shipment. The quantities were cut and we will not be receiving any more helmets this year from them. She also contacted the four clubs in the area that received helmets and has not been able to get any from them either.

Claire forgot to contact Kids Academy about presenting BrainMinders to them. Bea will contact the director to apooigize and find out if they want us to present the program later in the summer.

**Youth:** Claire and Myra attended the Chiles Anchors end of year Banquet and Installation. It was very nice and was attended by Anchors, parents and Pilots. At the banquet we presented the seniors with a PI bookmark and an anchor charm for the girls and an anchor key chain for the boys.

**Anchor Update:** We received a copy of the invoice paid letter from PI showing Leon High Anchors International dues for 2006-2007 was paid. Our club paid \$432 for the 2004-2006 past District dues for Leon High Anchors. Anchor charms and anchor key chains were given to the Chiles Anchors along with their Provisional letters. Maclay and Leon Anchors did not receive them because the sponsors did not provide the names to Claire. Next year, Claire will get the names of the Anchors at the beginning of the school year because the sponsors are too busy at the end of the year to provide the information.

Bridget explained to the members that the Foundation is a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. The money that comes into the Foundation cannot be given to a for profit organization. One of the functions of the Foundation is to provide scholarships to the Anchors. Claire will forward the information she received from Dene' Dixon to the Foundation board. Bridget will let the Pilot members know when the Foundation meeting will be so that Pilots can attend and learn the roles of each board member and what is discussed. ## sad news

Former Pilot Mickey (Marian Conn) Bashinski passed away on June 4, 2007 in Newport News, VA. Burial is in the national cemetery in Portland, Oregon. No memorial service is planned for Tallahassee. Donations to Alzheimer's Foundation of America are welcomed.

Born in 1918 in St. Cloud, FL, Mickey graduated from Florida State College for Women (now F.S.U.) and later returned to Tallahassee to be near her sister and brother, Lois "Connie" Cook Easley and Dr. James Conn after her husband Capt. (USN) Horace M. Bashinski died in 1961 while on active duty in Portland. She earned advanced degrees from F.S.U. and was a published author during her tenure as a professor there. During her teaching career, she taught every grade from preschool through graduate school.

She is survived by her sister; daughter Lucinda Drossner of Virginia; son Horace "Chip" Bashinski of Apopka, FL; 6 grandchildren; and 8 great grandchildren.

## momma's punch

**6 cups Water**  
**4 cups Sugar**  
**2 1/2 cups Orange Juice**  
**2 medium Lemons**  
**5 medium Bananas**  
**1 cup Pineapple Juice**  
**4 1/2 Sprite, 2-liter bottles**

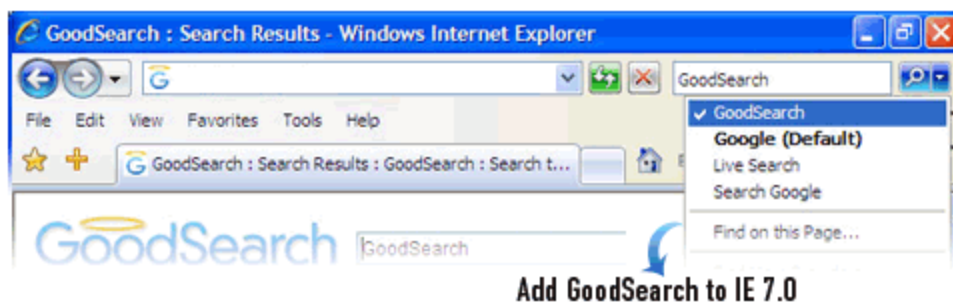
1. Bring water and sugar to a boil or until sugar is melted.
2. Combine 2nd set of ingredients (mash bananas in the blender)

4. Divide into quart size containers and freeze until solid.
5. When ready to serve, slightly thaw the punch mixture and mix equal parts punch mix and lemon-lime soda.
6. Punch should be served slightly slushy.
